Karen Maniaci will write a letter to the Downtown Development Authority requesting funds for the museum's annual budget.

Mike Busen's Allen Park Boy Scouts need to perform Community Service hours. They would like to do some work at the museum to accomplish this.

MAYOR'S REPORT, Tom Karnes: The governor appointed a team to review the City's finances. They have sixty days to decide on recommendations for Lincoln Park's future.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT, Muriel Lobb: The side steps in the back of the museum need to be repaired. The bottom part of the back of the museum, to the right of the porch, also needs to be repaired. Muriel requests that the Commissioners check to see if the extra siding could be installed there.

\$575 in memorial donations were made in honor of Helen Flynn. This was added to the D-Account.

CURATOR'S REPORT, Jeff Day: The new exhibit and reception for the Clemente family was a great success. The family donated \$500 to the Historical Society.

Jeff, Jim Nelson and Joe Turinsky are making a list of "Legends of Lincoln Park" for future exhibits.

at the Historical Society meeting on March 12, at 7

The Annual Dinner of the Historical Society is May 3, 6 pm.
