**ORDER NO. 6 AMENDED**

**ORDER OF THE EMERGENCY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF LINCOLN PARK  
PARTIAL RESTORATION OF CITY COUNCIL COMPENSATION**

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BY THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN THE EMERGENCY MANAGER FOR THE CITY OF LINCOLN PARK  
PURSUANT TO MICHIGAN'S PUBLIC ACT 436 OF 2012  
BRAD COULTER, THE EMERGENCY MANAGER, ISSUES THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

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WHEREAS, under the Local Financial Stability and Choice Act, Act 436, Public Acts of Michigan, 2012 ("Act 436"), Brad Coulter has been appointed as the Emergency Manager (the "EM") of the City of Lincoln Park, County of Wayne, Michigan (the "City"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 9(2) of Act 436, the EM "shall act for and in the place and stead of" the Mayor, the City Manager, as the Chief Administrative Officer, and of the City Council, as the governing body of the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 13 of Act 436 on July 7, 2014 Council salary, wages or other compensation were eliminated; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 13 of Act 436, the EM "may restore, in whole or in part, any of the salary, wages, other compensation, or benefits of the chief administrative officer and members of the governing body during the pendency of the receivership, for such time and on such terms as the emergency manager considers appropriate, to the extent that the emergency manager finds that the restoration of salary, wages, compensation, or benefits is consistent with the financial and operating plan."; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Manager finds that partial restoration of salary is appropriate and consistent with the financial and operating plan.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Lincoln Park Mayor and City Council salary be partially restored at a rate of fifty percent. This Order shall become effective December 1, 2014.

2. The original order effective December 1, 2014 needs to be amended to include authorization over Home Funds. The amended order authorizes the City Council to have authority over and take the following actions:

- Approve Residential Rehab loan participation
- Approve Inner Agency Agreements for C.D.B.G./Home Funds
- Approve Sub-Recipient Agreements for C.D.B.G./Home Funds
- Schedule Public Hearings when required for the Dangerous Building Code of Appeals
- Schedule public hearings on proposed Traffic Control Orders
- Approve or Rescind Traffic Control Orders
- Approve requested Block Party petitions
- Authorize Service Organizations request to solicit on city streets (fundraisers)
- Establish Clean-Up Fix-Up Weeks and other volunteer projects
- Organize the annual master list of volunteer projects and park clean ups for the City.
- Approve “Annual Used Auto Dealer Licenses”
- Approve “Second Hand Dealer Licenses”
- Present Proclamations to various groups, businesses or LP residents when appropriate
- Proclaim “National Arbor Day”, “Child Abuse Awareness Week”, “National Public Works Week”, and other days of recognition.
- Schedule Special Open Meeting of the Mayor and Council if necessary
- Approve streetlight conversions/DTE, covered by the current Special Assessment
- Accept election results as certified by Wayne County
- Approve “Annual State Right of Way permits”
- Approve “Annual Wayne County Permit” thru the Public Service Engineering Division
- Other duties which may be delegated in writing from time to time by the Emergency Manager

3. All orders of the EM, ordinances, and resolutions of the City Council, and all parts of orders, ordinances, or resolutions, in conflict with this Order are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

4. If any component of this Order is declared illegal, unenforceable, or ineffective by a court of competent jurisdiction, such component shall be deemed severable so that all other components contained in this Order shall remain valid and effective.

5. The EM may modify, amend, rescind, replace, supplement, or otherwise revise this Order at any time.

6. Nothing in this Order shall be, or shall be deemed to be, a limitation, modification, waiver, or relinquishment by the EM of any right or power available under Act 436, all of which rights and powers are expressly preserved.

7. This Order shall be distributed to the Mayor, the Chief Administrative Officer, the City Council and the State of Michigan Department of Treasury.
