



NOTICE TO RESIDENTS

Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Work

The City of Lincoln Park conducted a survey of the sanitary sewer within your neighborhood in the 2013-2014 and as a result of the survey, the City is now proceeding with the rehabilitation of sewers that have been identified with interior surface deterioration, cracking within the pipe or leaking joints allowing groundwater to enter the sanitary sewer system. The City has recently contracted with Inland Waters Pollution Control of Detroit, Michigan to complete the installation of a cured-in-place pipe lining within those sewers identified with defects. You are receiving this notice as the main line sewer servicing your neighborhood is to be rehabilitated. Within the next week, Inland Waters Pollution Control will be cleaning the sewers to prepare for the lining installation.

During work on the sewer some residents may or may not experience an odor coming from your drains or toilets. We ask that you keep toilet lids closed and if possible, place a towel between the lid and seat. To reduce the chance of odor, please add water to all floor drains.

Once all sewers have been prepared for lining installation, Inland Waters Pollution Control will return to install the liner. You will receive another notice to notify you of the impending lining installation anticipated to take place within a couple weeks after the cleaning of sewers.
