Wayne County Taxpayers who owe 2013 and prior tax year property taxes can save their homes from foreclosure. Taxpayers owing 2014 or 2015 taxes can also take advantage of payment plans now.

If you own and live in your home, you are eligible for a **reduced interest payment agreement** that includes the following:

- Principal Residence Exemption
- Pay current taxes as scheduled
- Interest reduced from 18% to 6%
- Make 10% down payment
- Make the monthly payments
- Reduction in taxes to ½ of SEV

Make payments or enter into a payment agreement at the Wayne County Treasurer's Office before June 30, 2016

The Step Forward Michigan program is available for qualified applicants. To find out if you're eligible, apply online at stepforwardmichigan.org, or call (866) 946-7432.
