RESOLUTION 06-358 Authorize Payment/Cadillac Asphalt

WHEREAS, the City authorized Cadillac Asphalt to perform milling & asphalt overlay to Champaign Street, between the Bridge over I-75 and Lafayette Street for an amount of \$56,365.00, plus a 15% contingency, for a total price not to exceed \$64,865.00.

WHEREAS, Cadillac Asphalt has performed the work required, as inspected and approved by the Director of Public Services, for a total price of \$56,453.10.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City to expedite payment to Cadillac Asphalt for their timeliness and workmanship on this project.

THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council authorize payment in the amount of \$56,453.10 from Account #450.818 to Cadillac Asphalt for the milling and asphalt work performed on Champaign Street, between the bridge over I-75 and Lafayette Street.
