### **RESOLUTION 05-206 Personal Property Tax Collection/FAILED**

WHEREAS, the City of Lincoln Park sought proposals for personal property tax collection in an advertisement dated April 13, 2005; and

WHEREAS, A & W Collections was the sole bidder to propose a contract;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Clerk are authorized to execute a contract with A & W Collections to perform collection services of delinquent personal property taxes for a term beginning March 29, 2005 for a period of one year with the option to renew for one year. The Contractor will receive the following compensation: All administrative fees and all pre-delinquent interest and penalties levied on delinquent personal property taxes collected during the duration of this agreement, and all interest (1%/m) computed on delinquent City, School and Community College taxes collected during the duration of this agreement. Any other or additional services rendered by the Contractor to the City shall be paid on an hourly basis agreed upon by written authorization of the Mayor and Council prior to rendering the service.

**RESOLUTION 05-209 Oppose HR 1126**

By Councilwoman Brady, supported by Councilman Higgins  
WHEREAS, the City of Lincoln Park relies on the Wayne County Downriver System and Treatment Plant for conveyance of its sanitary sewerage, and  
WHEREAS, the Wayne County Downriver System and Treatment Plant practice the process blending sanitary sewerage in order to adequately treat its wastewater, successfully meeting its discharge limits over 99% of the time, and  
WHEREAS, meeting the non-blending requirements would require the acquisition of large parcels of land, storage volumes, and an enormous cost to construct such facilities.  
THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council express its support for sanitary sewerage blending and is in opposition to H.R. 1126.
