**RESOLUTION 06-114 Interlocal Agreement/SE MI Info Alliance**

WHEREAS, the City of Southgate has expended large sums to put in place and refine an information system which the Cities of Lincoln Park, Allen Park, Melvindale and Wyandotte find desirable;

WHEREAS, the parties to this agreement find it to be in their mutual interests to share the technology and thereby average down the costs thereof and at the same time improve the quality of public safety protection which they can provide to the community; and

WHEREAS, the parties have reached an agreement concerning the details of sharing of costs and responsibilities in a way which is fair and equitable for all and believe that this agreement should be set out in writing, pursuant to the requirements of the Public Act 35 of 1951, the same being MCL 124.1 et seq

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Lincoln Park joins the Interlocal Agreement to create a governmental entity referred to as "Southern Michigan Information Alliance"

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Clerk are authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf of the City of Lincoln Park.

**RESOLUTION 06-115 Video Surveillance/Police Dept**

RESOLVED, that Mayor and Council waive the bidding process and authorize the Police Chief or designee and the Purchasing Specialist to purchase a Digital Video Recorder (DVR) for the Police Department; and  
RESOLVED, that the entire system be purchased from Premium Protection, Inc. as it has the lowest quote of three quotes obtained for this system or similar system, with costs not to exceed \$4,500.00; and  
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that money for the purchase of this system come from the Vice Account 101.000.370V and the Narcotics Forfeiture Account 101.000.370CU.
