HUD requires the City to hold a Public Hearing prior to the adoption of the C.D.B.G. Budget approval. Joan Hennessey will be working on a five year consolidated plan for the department. This hearing was scheduled to allow the public and various service organizations the opportunity to provide input into the anticipated fund usage.

Regulations limit the amount that may be used for Program Administration to 20% and Public Services are limited to 15% of Block Grant money.

The city is anticipates receiving \$601,333 for this program year.
