HUD requires the City to hold a Public Hearing prior to adoption of the C.D.B.G. Budget. The purpose of this hearing is to afford the public and various service organizations the opportunity to provide input into the anticipated fund usage.

2014/15 40<sup>th</sup> Program Year which will commence on July 1, 2014. HUD regulations limit the amount that may be used for Program Administration to 20% and for Public Services the limit is 15% of Block Grant Funds received.

Asst. Director, Doreen Christian began by presenting a detailed report on the department request.
