Mayor Karnes gave an overview of the report findings received from Governor Rick Snyder and the Governors' determination regarding the financial emergency that currently exists within the local government.

The conclusion of the Governor is as follows:

“Based upon the foregoing information, the Review Team confirmed the findings of the preliminary review, the determination of the Local Emergency Financial Assistance Loan Board, and concluded that a financial emergency existed within the City. After thoroughly reviewing the report of the Review Team, I concur with their conclusion. Therefore, pursuant to Section 6(1)(b) of the Act, I have determined that a local government financial emergency exists within the City of Lincoln Park.”

*Councilwoman Henderson entered the meeting.

The Mayor and Council has the option of appealing the Governors' decision; within the time frame outlined in the Public Act, if they so choose. No action will be taken at this time.
