The City of Lincoln Park authorized Hennessey Engineers, 13500 Reeck Road, Southgate, MI. under the supervision of James D. Hollandsworth, P.E. to conduct a S2 Grant Program and prepare a comprehensive Project Plan for submittal to the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality recommending corrective action to the existing system through rehabilitation or replacement of existing sewers with severe defects and improvement to the outlet control for the retention treatment basin.

Project Manager Ryan Kern, P.E. gave an overview of the Program. The City of Lincoln Park has been awarded two (2) S2 Grants.

Phase 1. Cost of Project was \$750,000 of which the City received grant monies totaling \$675,000 from MDEQ. Approved in December 2011

Phase 2. \$361,000 total cost for the project of which City received grant monies totaling \$325,000 from MDEQ. Approved in October 2013

Copies of the report have been made available for inspection by the public to review at the office of City Clerk, 1355 Southfield Rd., Lincoln Park, MI for a period of 30 days.

The deadline to submit the plan to MDEQ is July 1st, 2015.
