



Lincoln Park Residents will begin receiving new 96 gallon refuse containers the week of June 16, 2014
Heavy duty, forest green, with hinged lids and large wheels.

Lincoln Park, MI – In an effort to keep our city clean residents will begin receiving forest green colored 96-gallon refuse carts the week of June 16, 2014 as part of the city's new refuse hauling contract with Rizzo Environmental Services.

More than 14,000 refuse carts will be delivered to single family homes in Lincoln Park by the end of June and the first week in July. Until then, homeowners are to continue placing refuse at the curb in plastic bags or trash cans that they are currently using.

Homeowners are urged to switch over to their new Rizzo carts once they receive them. Please continue to place yard waste and bulky waste items out where you currently place them. We have also included a separate flyer that shows you how the carts need to be set out for collection.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

- Q: What can I put in the new trash cart? Regular household garbage only.**
- Q: Should I place garbage in plastic bags before filling the cart? Yes - to eliminate odors, spills and rodents.**
- Q: If my cart is full what do I do with the additional garbage bags? For the occasional bag or two, please place alongside your cart. If needed a second cart can be purchased for \$75 by calling 866-772-8900**
- Q: Can I put Yard Waste into the refuse cart? No - yard waste will continue to be collected separately.**
- Q: Can I put Bulk Waste into the refuse cart? No - bulk waste will continue to be collected separately.**
- Q: Are smaller containers available? No - only the 96 gallon size carts are available.**
- Q: Can I put my address on the refuse cart? Yes - carts are coded to the individual address and remain with the home/property.**
- Q: How early can I put my refuse cart out for collection? No earlier than 5:00 p.m. the day before your pickup but always have it out at the curb before 7:00 a.m. the day of your collection.**
- Q: Where should I place my cart for proper collection? Please place your trash cart in the street, close to the curb and next to your driveway. See the sheet showing proper cart placement for effective collection.**
- Q: What should I do if my refuse cart is stolen? The first cart is provided free to each home and is coded to match your address. If a police report of the stolen cart is provided then the cart will be replaced at no cost.**
- Q: What should I do with my old trash containers? You could use them for additional yard waste containers or for storage. If you want them to be picked up as trash, then please attach a sign on them saying "garbage - please take this can or cart".**
