Lincoln Park Farmers Market, founded 2007, is a local farmers market with farmers with local produce and plants, specialty food vendors with baked goods, jams, honey, maple syrup and spices as well as crafter vendors with handmade craft items.

LINCOLN PARK FARMERS MARKET

Lincoln Park Farmers Market is organized and run by Friends of Lincoln Park Farmers Market, a Michigan non-profit corporation and IRS 501c3 organization. Our mission is to promote healthy lifestyles and access to locally grown foods.

Lincoln Park Farmers Market, founded in 2007, was Downriver's first farmers market and Wayne County's first Sunday market.

WE ARE A 100% VOLUNTEER RUN MARKET.

We are a small farmers market. We attract approximately two hundred people, on average, per week and approximately three to twelve vendors per week depending on the weather and if it is a holiday week or not.

We do a variety of special events through the market season. We also have the MSU Extension Office for Wayne County out for four weeks of the summer to distribute nutritional information to our customers. We also had Henry Ford Health Systems out to the market to do a cooking demonstration, with samples, as well as nutritional information.

We are members of the Michigan Farmers Market Association and the Farmers Market Coalition.



OUR VENDORS

Our farmers come to Lincoln Park, each Sunday, from Wayne, Monroe and Washtenaw Counties. They bring with them locally grown produce and plants.



Our specialty food vendors sell baked goods, honey, maple syrup, jams, dried herbs, spice rubs, kettle corn, salsa, BBQ sauce and other good things.



Our crafts vendors come to the market with handmade craft items such as jewelry, soy candles, silk flower arrangements, wood crafts, crocheted items and other



FOOD ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

We participate in numerous food assistance programs to have fresh local foods accessible to all. We accept Bridge Card, credit and debit at our market. We also participate in Fair Food Network's Double Up Food Bucks program that doubles what a Bridge Card recipient can spend at a farmers market, up to \$20 per day, for fresh fruits and vegetables. We accept WIC Project Fresh and Senior Project Fresh/Market Fresh as well. We also accept credit/debit.
