



## **NOTICE TO RESIDENTS**

### **Pagel Avenue Reconstruction and Water Main Replacement (West of Wilson Avenue to West of Electric Avenue)**

Through a selective bidding process, the City of Lincoln Park has awarded RVP Construction of South Rockwood, Michigan a contract to complete the water main replacement and road reconstruction of Pagel Avenue from west of Wilson Avenue to west of Electric Avenue.

To date, the new water main has been installed and transferring of individual water services to the new main is currently taking place. Also storm sewer drainage has also been installed. However, due to the lateness in the season and the uncertainty of when the winter weather will be upon us, it has been decided to postpone the road replacement until the early Spring.

Prior to the Contractor suspending work for the winter months, the entire site will be cleaned up for safe access for vehicles and pedestrians. The following items will be completed prior to the temporary suspension of work:

- All water main work will be completed so that all residents are being served by the newly installed water main
- All drainage structures will be raised to existing roadway grade and temporary asphalt will be placed where roadway has been removed for storm sewer installation. The Contractor, RVP Construction, will maintain temporary pavements as needed through the Winter months.
- All sidewalk removed for water main installation will be poured back to original conditions.
- All excess debris and stockpiles of material will be removed from the site and all sidewalks cleared for pedestrian access.

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- Any driveway approaches that were disturbed will have temporary pavements placed.

We apologize for any inconvenience that this work is causing, but trust that you will understand the benefit of completing a quality project by completing the work in early Spring.
